



Summer Internship Announcement

The Alleghany Foundation in Covington, Virginia, is again sponsoring a summer internship program in 2012 for up to two undergraduate or graduate students who desire experience related to philanthropy, the non-profit sector, research, economic development, communications, or community service in the Alleghany Highlands. Internships are for a period of at least six consecutive weeks during the summer and may extend up to eight weeks. The starting date is approximately June 1, but negotiable. The Foundation provides a stipend of \$275/week for this internship as well as an additional housing stipend if the intern does not live within commuting distance of The Alleghany Foundation.

Natives of the Alleghany Highlands, residents, and/or students attending accredited colleges or universities in the state or region are eligible to apply. Applicants must demonstrate an interest in philanthropy, the non-profit sector, economic development and/or community service. Applicants must also demonstrate strong communication skills, personal responsibility, self-motivation, strong computer skills, and the willingness to support Foundation staff.

This internship provides a unique opportunity for a student to explore his/her interests with the goal of informing future career pathways. Preference is given to students who have completed a minimum of two years of college coursework. Interested candidates should send a resume and brief writing sample to The Alleghany Foundation, P.O.
